LOCAL BYLAWS

1. **Authority** - These Local Bylaws have been read and approved by the American Dart Association and are a secondary source of information created in accordance with and in addition to the League Rules Manual. The League Rules Manual is your primary source of information and all rules in the Manual will be followed.

2. **Fees** - Weekly fees is as follows: (Per Week)

Team League
Fees shall be \$2200

Express League
Fees shall be \$18.00

Both teams shall pay equally for machine use during the match. Team captains are encouraged to pay by check or money order to avoid accounting discrepancies and possible loss or theft during transmittal (Make payable to D Best Supplies). Captains only write checks. All fees paid in cash are subject to count upon receipt in the League Office. All insufficient fund checks will be handled by Credit Check Of Colorado. If checks are not taken care of through CrediCheck by the end of the season the Team will not receive awards or prize money till this has been done.

Sponsor's Fee – Fee for Team League shall be \$63.00 per team (\$4.50/team/week) for a fourteen-week season. Fee for Express League shall be \$32.00 per team (\$4.00/team/week) for an eight-week season. A sponsor or the team members will pay fee in full at the start of the season. Fee will be paid back 100% to the players as prize money.

3. **Delinquent Fees** - These are due in full from all teams the night of play regardless of forfeits or the number of matches played. If all funds are not current the week following default, one point will be deducted from that team's cumulative total; the second week two points will be deducted. Teams not current at the end of three consecutive weeks will be dropped from the league roster. In order to be reinstated Team and or Team members must pay a fee of \$20.00, plus all fees in arrears.

4. **Pick-Up And Drop-Off System For The Team Envelopes** - In order to expedite drop off and delivery of the envelopes for the League play, all envelopes will be picked up at The Break/Leo's Place. Envelopes will be counted before leaving The Break/Leo's Place, and if money is incorrect, it is the visiting captain's responsibility. Visiting captains are responsible for delivering envelopes to The Break/Leo's Place, the next day following play by 7:00 PM. The visiting team will have two points deducted from their cumulative points if this does not happen on time.

5. **Awards** - Will be handed out the night of Finals at the top seeded location of the Team still left in the play-offs. A representative from each team must be in attendance to receive your money and awards, or have made arrangements with the DR or League Office beforehand; otherwise awards are forfeited. If it is to be a member other than the Captain you must call the DR or League Office and give the ok for that person.

6. **Board Use During League Play** - There will *only* be one Board used per two teams, during League Play. (The only exception to this is if it is 10 p.m. or later and three or

more matches are left. To speed things up the use of two Boards will be used). This must be an agreement between both team captains.

7. **Score sheets** - It is the captain's responsibility to be sure that the PPDA, starting Score, points remaining, total darts, and bonus points are correct- Both captains need to work together: start of each game both captains go to the board, home team captain has score sheet, away team captain enters the information from the score sheet to the board. Both captains **MUST** make sure all information is correct. After game is played **BOTH** captains, home captain with score sheet, away captain relaying information from board to score sheet. **MAKE** sure score sheet is correct before both captains sign, this is the way it will be **entered into the computer, no changes.**
8. **GAME RULES** - The ADA League Rules Manual will be the authority for all American Dart League matches.
9. **Rescheduled Matches** – If both captains agree, a team match may be scheduled for a different night. Once the day and time has been determined **both captains** must contact the Division Rep or League Office and confirm the reschedule before the date is changed. This becomes the new match date and the old one is ignored. All reschedules must be played before the last two weeks of the season.
10. **Schedule Changes** - There will be no change to the original Schedule Sheet for the finals. This is so the rest of the Teams know what day finals will be played. All information will be posted at the bottom of your stat sheet, "who and where," so make sure and read them.
11. **Penalties For Late Rosters** - Team rosters must be turned in one week prior to season starting or there will be a \$20.00 late fee. This does not include any **Brand New First Time Members starting a Team.**
12. **Bye Week Points** - Are not included in the pay out at the end of the season. These points are only used to seed teams during regular season.
13. **Inclement Weather Policy** -Severe weather warnings or traveler's advisory warnings are enough to re-schedule team matches. Please notify the League Office for assistance in re-scheduling.
15. **MVP** – To be able to qualify for the MVP Award you must be a regular player on an active Team for that season.
